She began her career with Texas Adult Protective Services as an investigator, went on to serve as the Community Service Director at Home Instead Senior Care, and worked in psychiatric services, home health, hospice care, and now in brain injury rehabilitation.

Serving the community where she resides is the most important part of each career move. The opportunity to give back and to help enrich the lives of others is what gives her the most satisfaction from the work she does. Mrs. Mansion has served on several boards throughout her career. Notably, Mrs. Mansion was instrumental in starting and facilitating the El Paso Brain Injury Support Group, as well as establishing the Love Brain Injury Fund which provides funding to survivors of brain injuries so that they are able to get the rehabilitation they need.

In 2017, Mrs. Mansion hopes to continue her work and advocacy here in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. Through outreach, education, and volunteer work, she hopes to continue to touch the lives of those living with and surviving brain injury.
